Minutes:

January 13, 2002 Meeting

The minutes of the September and November 2001 meetings were read and approved. There was one amendment to the November minutes, being that the meeting date was changed from January 12 to January 13.

It was noted by Celia Evans that we will not be billed for the dressage arena for the April 2001 show. The fee has been waived due to Celia's various contributions.

Old Business:

January Show: The January 2002 show will start at 8:30 am, so the “In-Hand” clinic that was proposed will not be held.

Liability Insurance for the club was discussed. Mike Smith will get quotes per show –vs- per day. Coverage will be purchased before the January show: moved by D. Coddling, 2nd by T. Gentzel and all were in favor. It was noted that liability protection has been under discussion for close to a year. The club agreed to make this a priority.

Judges are needed for upcoming shows. It was noted that we do not have judges secured for the following show dates: 05/19, 10/19, and 10/20. President B. Heberling believes the dates are covered, but will continue to pursue this issue, so the judging coverage is secured.

Sites of 2002 shows were discussed. Concern was expressed regarding using club members' farms for our show grounds. After discussion, it was decided for certain shows, this is currently our best option. It was confirmed that the March 2002 show will be held

at the farm of B. Lender: moved by D. Codding, 2nd by L. Starr and all present were in agreement.

The Clarcona shows were discussed. It was noted that there are three show dates confirmed at the Clarcona Horseman's Park, but we are unsure of the dates. Dates will be confirmed.

New Business:

The State Fair Show was discussed: there will be a Western Division and Trail, although this was inadvertently left off from the program.

Year End Awards: It was questioned if the Short Stirrup and Hunter Divisions had been combined. If so, the divisions should not have been combined. Thalia Gentzel tallied the points and she agreed to review the process to confirm whether or not the divisions were split.

It was requested that Year End Award categories be listed, printed out and made available, so that members can be aware of what awards are available.

Current scoring practices were reviewed. It was decided that the SWA point system should mirror that of the WPCSA. If there are 3 competitors in a class the points will be awarded as: 5,3,2,1. With two in the class, first place receives 2 points and if one is in the class, 1

point is received. It was also noted that Division Champions will be awarded a ribbon at the show, but will not receive points for the championship: moved by H. Miller, 2nd by L. Stewart, and all present were in favor.

The current Year End Divisions were discussed. It was decided that we will maintain our current list of divisions, but will add a Walk-Trot Division Champion (to include all WPCSA walk and walk-trot classes, including ridden and showmanship): moved by T. Gentzel, 2nd by H. Miller and all present were in favor.

The possibility of hosting a *WPCSA Judges Clinic* was announced. It has been looked into and the U.F. Equine Teaching Hospital would be an appropriate venue. It was noted that such an event would require support from the entire club, as all divisions would need to be filled. Thalia Gentzel agreed to pursue additional information re: such a clinic from the WPCSA. The club decided to pursue the clinic: moved by D. Codding, 2nd by T. Gentzel and all present were in favor.

Junior memberships were discussed, as such memberships do not require a fee, but it is required that a membership form be completed. These forms will be available at each show and a copy will be available on the SWA website.

Arrangements for the January 2002 show were noted: The jumping, driving and trail courses will be set up by Dragons Lair in their north field and the south field will be available for parking. J. Marshall and H. Miller volunteered to act as ring stewards.

Possible hosting of a future WPCSA AGM was discussed. It was decided that we will pursue hosting of the 2004 AGM. H. Miller will attend the 2002 AGM and agreed to submit the request: moved by M. Smith, 2nd by C. Evans and all present were in favor.

SWA membership in the WPCSA was discussed and will be pursued. Benefits were noted to include being listed automatically in the Member/Breeder Directory and that we would be notified of new WPCSA members in our area. Treasurer M. Smith will mail our dues: moved by T. Gentzel, 2nd by D. Codding and all present were in favor.

Next Meeting:

Our next meeting will be at noon on April 14, 2002 at the home of George and Thalia Gentzel and will be a potluck. With no further business the meeting was adjourned.
